▼ **'Romeo', Meridiani**

Although this sideboard by Andrea Parisio comes in 16 lacquer tones, we think it looks best in this verdant, grounding green. For a soft aesthetic, pair it with rounded furniture. From £9,030 (meridiani.it).



▼ **'Hide & Seek', Gallotti & Radice**

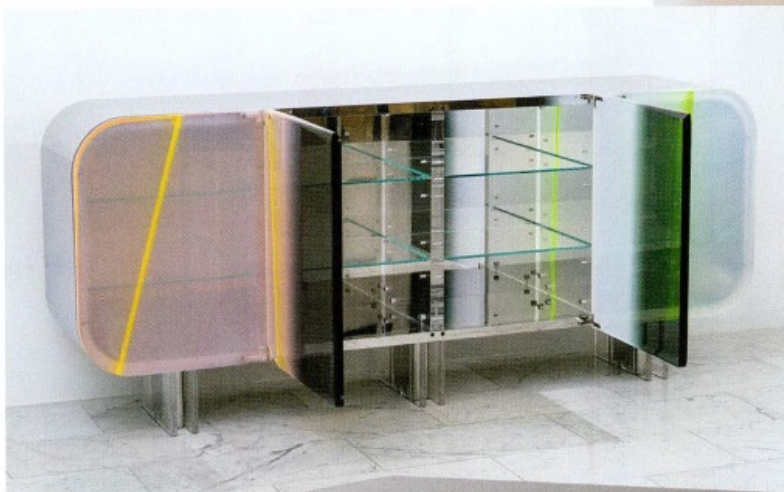
▲ **'Earl', Flexform**
